



CalGETS Authorization Process



Provider Prerequisites

- Licensed in California to engage in the practice of mental health
 - MD, PsyD, PhD, RP, MFT, LCSW, or LPCC – in good standing
 - Student therapists in their final year of acquiring a license may apply
- Comprehensive general liability insurance with the following coverage:
 - Each occurrence \$1,000,000; General aggregate \$1,000,000
- Professional liability insurance with \$1,000,000 per occurrence and an aggregate of not less than \$3,000,000
- HIPAA compliant clinical office policies

Process

1. Complete the CalGETS provider application by clicking [here](#)
2. Submit provider application, license and insurance to ugsp@mednet.ucla.edu
3. Complete self-guided online material prior to Phase I training
4. Attend CalGETS Phase I virtual training for 3 days, 4 hours per day
5. Add Regents of the University of California as an additional insured
6. Submit UCLA Substitute W-9 and CalGETS authorization packet
7. Complete 10 clinical guidance hours during first two years (at least 5 in first year)
8. Complete 5 CEUs related to gambling disorder on an annual basis starting in year two of CalGETS authorization

Other Information

- Phase I training is provided at no cost to the applicant
- Phase I training provides 10 CEU for MFTs and LCSWs
- Peer based clinical guidance sessions are provided via the CalGETS Provider Education and Resource Center (PERC)
